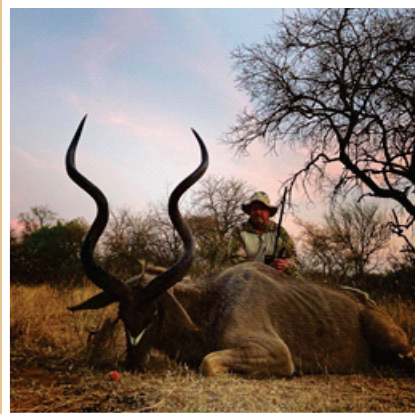
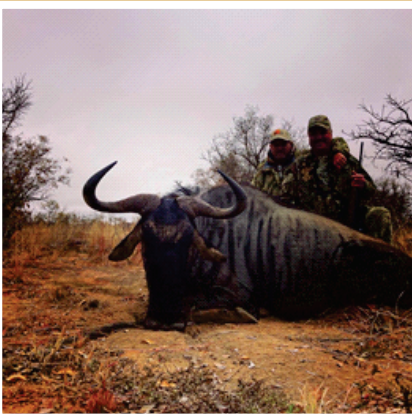
His wife Allison wrote "The most satisfying part of the experience was learning and visiting with our host and making memories with my husband whose passion is the great outdoors"
